HIV Medical Clinics

HIV medical clinics serve people who have already received an HIV diagnosis. They require a referral from another doctor, and provide HIV viral load monitoring, and information about appropriate medications. Many offices include a social worker or other support services. A health card is required to access their services without a fee. They do not typically do testing.

Saskatoon City Hospital-Positive Living Program

Outpatient care for persons in Central and Northern Saskatchewan who have tested positive for HIV and/or Hepatitis. Provides clinical assessments, immunization, education, referrals. Team includes nurse, pharmacist, social worker, gastroenterologist, and internal medicine specialist.
